With regards to the 32 day account, a more in depth explanation is needed. This account was opened in 2016.

There is an outstanding balance of £6876.40 payable to Birketts for Professional Services. In order to pay this, and leave sufficient funds in the Treasurers Account for any outgoings through to the end of the financial year, I tried to transfer £8000 from the 32 Day Account. It became apparent that the minimum amount that can be transferred is £10,000 AND a minimum balance of £10,000 must be kept in the account. Not only this, but it literally is 32 days before any transferred funds will appear in another account. This basically means that the £18,382.02 in the 32 Day Account cannot be used while ever it is in this account.

As there is the outstanding payment to Birketts now due, and without sufficient funds in the combined balance of the Treasurers Account and Business Account, it was thought that the best
